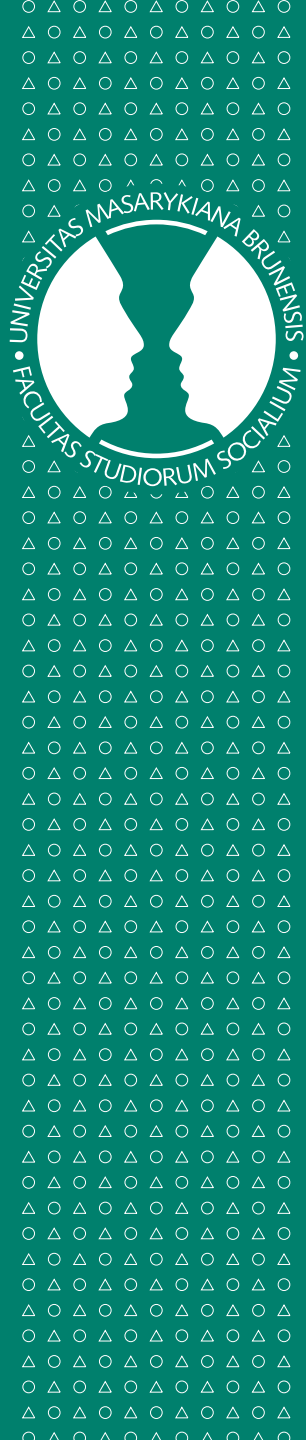
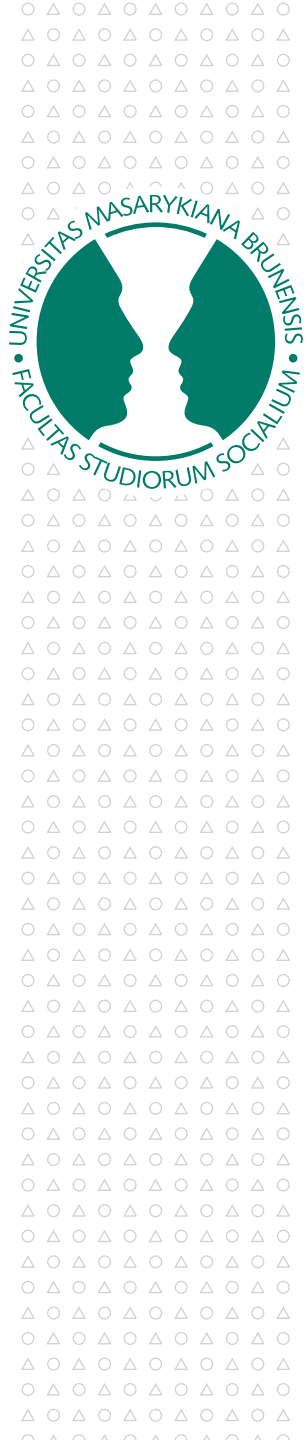

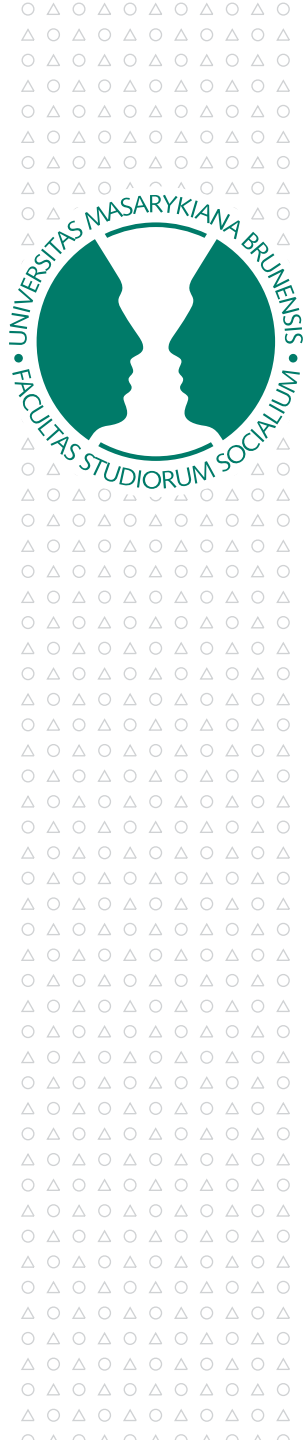


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About Us

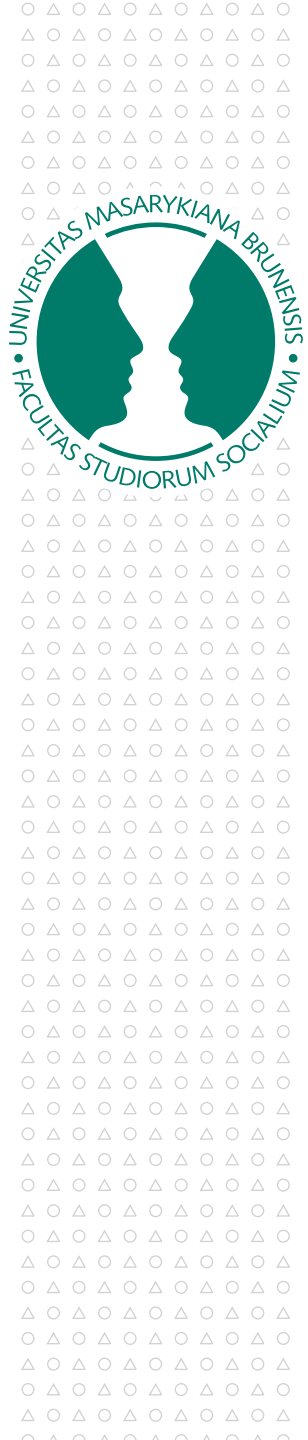

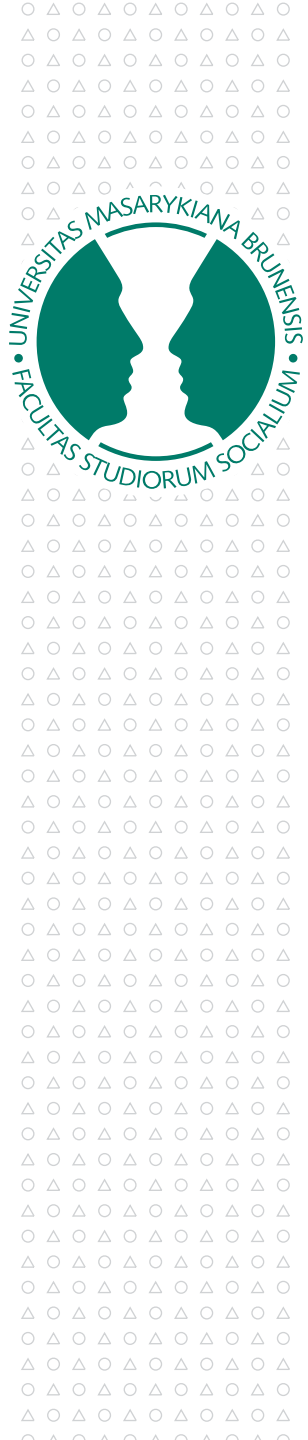

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Research Question

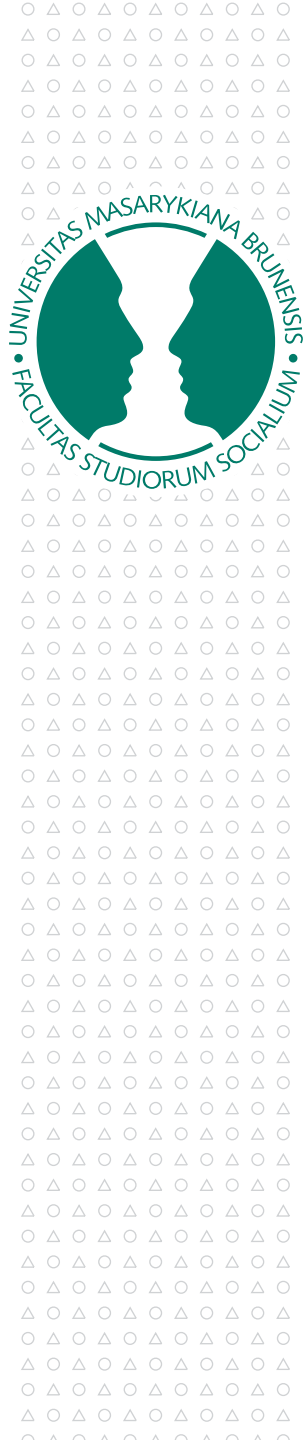

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Czech / Norwegian Comparison

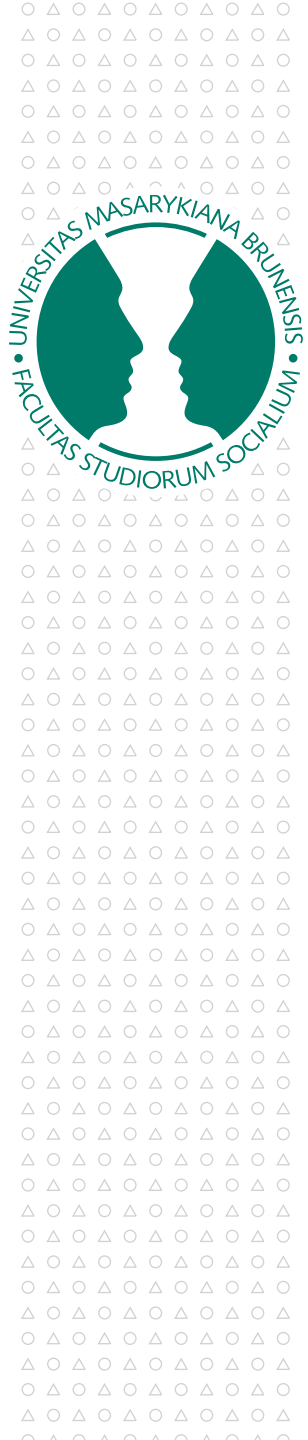
