The Scholarships

- Full Scholarship (covering tuition, hostel and partial academic and living expenses), Tuition Scholarship or Half-tuition Scholarship per academic year for each awardee.
- Renewable on an annual basis and tenable for a period of up to the normal duration of study, subject to continued outstanding academic performance.

Curriculum

For 2014-15 academic year, non-local applicants will be considered on individual basis, subject to the availability of places, for broad-based admission to 4-year curriculum. Applicants with suitable credit transfers may be admitted to be Year 3 students with Major/Stream/Discipline Major allocated.

Eligibility

 Non-local applicants (other than Hong Kong and the Chinese Mainland citizens) are persons entering Hong Kong for the purpose of education with a student visa/entry permit issued by the Director of Immigration of the HKSAR Government.

Application

- Non-local applicants should have attained at a recognised post-secondary institution outside Hong Kong an equivalent qualification as stipulated below:
- a degree or a sub-degree awarded by a recognised post-secondary institution;
- an International Baccalaureate Diploma;
- High School Diploma plus a minimum of 1650 on SAT I:
- satisfactory completion of the first year in an undergraduate curriculum or the first year of a sub-degree programme of a recognised post-secondary institution; or
- other equivalent qualifications* which the University will consider on a case-by-case basis.
- Non-local applicants may be required to achieve a minimum of Grade C in English in the GCE O-Level or GCSE Examination or an equivalent public examination; or Grade 4 or above in International Baccalaureate English Language; or a TOEFL score of 213 in the computer-based test, or 550 in the paper-based test, or 79 in the internet-based test; or an IELTS overall band score of 6.0.
