Non-local Student Scholarships for Undergraduate Studies at Lingnan University, Hong Kong

I am pleased to let you know that Lingnan University will continue to offer Non-local Student Scholarships for outstanding non-local students to study in our University's undergraduate programmes in 2014-15 academic year which begins in September 2014. Full Scholarship (covering tuition, hostel and partial academic and living expenses), Tuition Scholarship or Half-tuition Scholarship per academic year will be awarded to successful students. The Scholarship, which is tenable for a period of up to the normal duration of study, is renewable annually subject to continued outstanding academic performance.

Lingnan University is the only liberal arts university in the territory, offering study programmes in Arts, Business and Social Sciences at undergraduate and postgraduate levels up to doctoral degrees. True to its identity as a liberal arts institution, Lingnan is characterised by a small student body, a close faculty-student relationship and a residential campus. Lingnan guarantees on-campus residence for all non-local students throughout their studies. Local and non-local applicants with the following qualifications are eligible to apply:

- a degree or a sub-degree awarded by a recognised post-secondary institution;
- an International Baccalaureate Diploma;
- High School Diploma plus a minimum of 1650 on SAT I;
- satisfactory completion of the first year in an undergraduate curriculum or the first year of a sub-degree programme of a recognised post-secondary institution;
- Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination results; or
- other equivalent qualifications which the University will consider on a case-by-case basis.

(Note: Non-local applicants may be required to achieve a minimum of Grade C in English in the GCE O-Level or GCSE Examination or an equivalent public examination; or Grade 4 or above in International Baccalaureate English Language; or a TOEFL score of 213 in the computer-based test, or 550 in the paper-based test, or 79 in the internet-based test; or an IELTS overall band score of 6.0.)

The relevant leaflets/posters on the Scholarships are enclosed for distribution and publicity at your institution. Interested students should submit their online applications no later than 31 March 2014 for evaluation for admission.
