The European & Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership (hereinafter referred to as "EDCTP") is a public-public partnership to be implemented in accordance with the Article 185 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, under which European and sub-Saharan African countries cooperate to make progress in the struggle against HIV/AIDS, malaria, tuberculosis and other Poverty Related Diseases that have a significant negative socio-economic impact on the development of African countries. The main goal of the EDCTP programme is to concentrate limited resources and coordinate efforts of European and sub-Saharan African countries in clinical research and particularly phase II-III trials aiming at development of new or improved diagnostics, drugs, vaccines, and microbicides for the three main Poverty Related Diseases: HIV/AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis. Following satisfactory results achieved to date under the current EDCTP programme (2003-2015), the second EDCTP programme (EDCTP2; 2014-2023) will see an expansion to support all stages of clinical trials, from phase I to IV, though the main focus will remain on phases II and III. Additionally, EDCTP2 will include support to neglected infectious diseases (NIDs)¹. EDCTP2 will form an integral part of EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation Horizon 2020 and by means of coordination of European and sub-Saharan African countries' national programmes will contribute to the reduction of socio-economic burden of Poverty Related and Neglected Infectious Diseases.
