## **Current programming period 2007-2013**

- Social infrastructures: education-, health-, childcare-, housing infrastructure (17,9 billion EUR)
- Education infrastructure: childcare, preschool, primary, secondary, tertiary education (8,4 billion EUR)
- Education and spatial segregation of Roma communities
- Sustainability of investments
  - Non-reformed education, social care, health systems
- Alignment with the most important trends and needs
  - Demographic change
  - Territorial inequalities
- Shift to the community-based care



# Programming period 2007-2013

- Comprehensive approaches (spatial targeting)
  - Slovakia 200 million EUR
  - Hungary (micro-regions) 320 million EUR
- Housing actions
  - Modification of the ERDF regulation (2010)
  - 80 million EUR (SK, HU, CZ, BG, RO, BG, etc.)

# **Programming tools**

### • Problem analysis

- Identification and addressing needs of target groups at highest risk of discrimination or social exclusion
- demographic challenges of regions or specific needs of geographical areas which suffer from severe and permanent natural or demographic....

### • Expected results

• Implementation reports on development of regions facing demographic challenges

### • Horizontal principles

- CPR, Art. 7 The Member States and the Commission shall take appropriate steps to prevent any discrimination based on sex, racial or ethnic origin, religion or belief, disability....
- CPR, Art. 96 ....specific actions to promote equal opportunities and prevent discrimination based on sex, racial or ethnic origin, religion or belief, disability....
- Addressing demographic challenge.....shrinking population.....ageing society
  - National and/or regional strategies
  - Adequacy and quality of education, training and social support structures
  - Cost effective provision of halthcare and long-term care
- Actions to .. prevent discrimination ... taking into account the needs of the various target groups at risk of such discrimination ...

Administrative capacity for the implementation and application of EU antidiscrimination law and policy in the field of ESI Funds

#### **Thematic**

#### Social inclusion, combating poverty and discrimination

#### National Roma Integration Strategies

Territorial concentration beyond the regional level (NUTS3)
