The JBC sees great importance in enabling international post-doctoral researchers to be part of its flourishing research environment and community. JBC post-doctoral Fellowships are intended to enable Fellows to devote themselves exclusively to their research with the purpose of reaching scientific and professional independence.

Grant Amount: \$22,000 per year and will only be granted if a matching sum will be provided by the fellow's supervisor. (Postdoctoral fellows will receive a competitive stipend for a period of one year, with a possibility of a one year extension).

Eligibility:

1. The candidate must be (or has been) a student in an accredited institution of higher education and whose PhD training and post-doctoral projects are in the field of Brain Sciences. The post-doctoral research will be conducted under the supervision of a JBC member.
2. The candidate has been granted a PhD no more than 3 years before applying for the Fellowship or has already submitted his doctoral thesis when applying. (The candidate will have received approval of the PhD, during the first academic year of post-doctoral studies).
