

II. Czech-Norwegian Research Conference Prague 2016



INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES

CONFERENCE VENUE

The conference is taking place at ****** Iris Hotel Eden**, Vladivostocka street 1539/2, Prague 10 which is located in a city part called Vršovice, about 20 minutes by tram from the city centre. The hotel is placed right in Eden Arena, a modern football stadium. Eden Arena is a home of Czech traditional football team S.K. Slavia Praha.

CURRENCY

The official currency of the Czech Republic is a Czech koruna (CZK). Our currency sign is Kč. An exchange rate might be around €1 ≈ 27 CZK.

REGISTRATION

Participation in the conference is free of charge. To get inside it is necessary to be registered. The [registration form](#) is available until 25th October, 2016.

LANGUAGE

The conference programme will be held in English and Czech. Interpretation services will be provided.

EVENT SERVICES

TRANSPORT

Transport options from Václav Havel Airport:

Taxi:

Iris Hotel Eden stands 30 km away from the airport. Taxi fare in the capital costs 27-30 CZK/1km. Taking a taxi might be faster way from the airport that may last 30 minutes to get there. It will cost about 800-900 CZK (one way).

Public transport:

Recommended route from the airport is to take

- 1) a bus no. 119 from the airport to Nadrazi Veleslavin stop
- 2) at Nadrazi Veleslavin stop transit to metro A to Namesti Miru stop
- 3) from Namesti Miru stop take a tram no. 22 to Slavia tram stop. This is the final stop. See the map below.

This route is expected to take 57 minutes.

Transport options from Praha Hlavní Nádraží (Central train station)

Recommended route from Praha hlavní nádraží is to take

- 1) Metro C to I.P. Pavlova stop
 - 2) from I.P. Pavlova transit to tram no. 22 to tram stop Slavia.
- This route is expected to take 26 minutes.

Public transport tickets are available at ticket machines at stops, news stands, at drivers and also via SMS.

CATERING

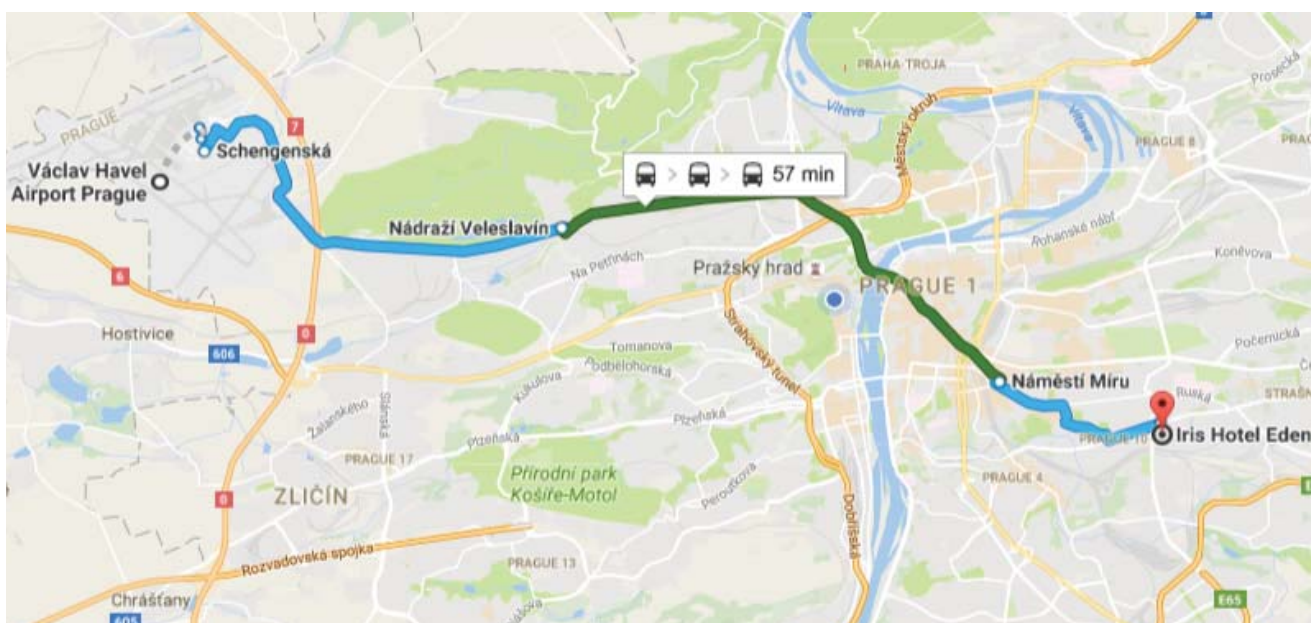

Catering company will not be able to cover all diet requirements.

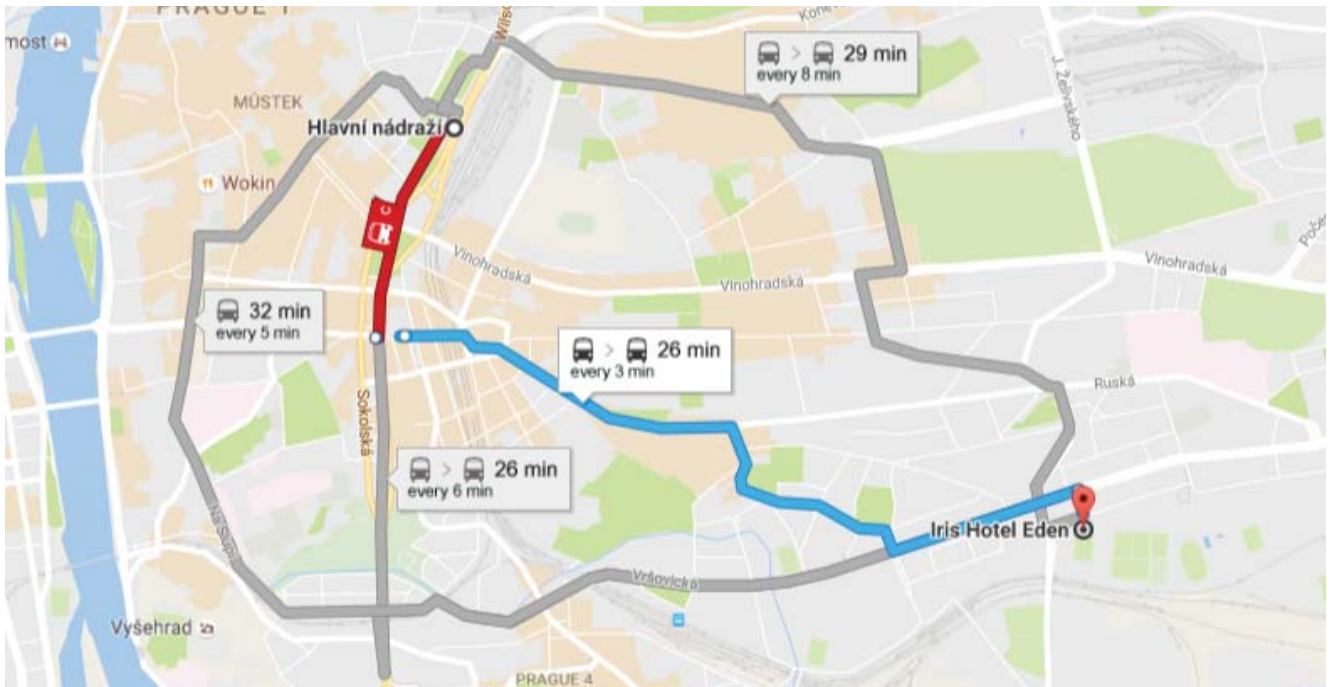

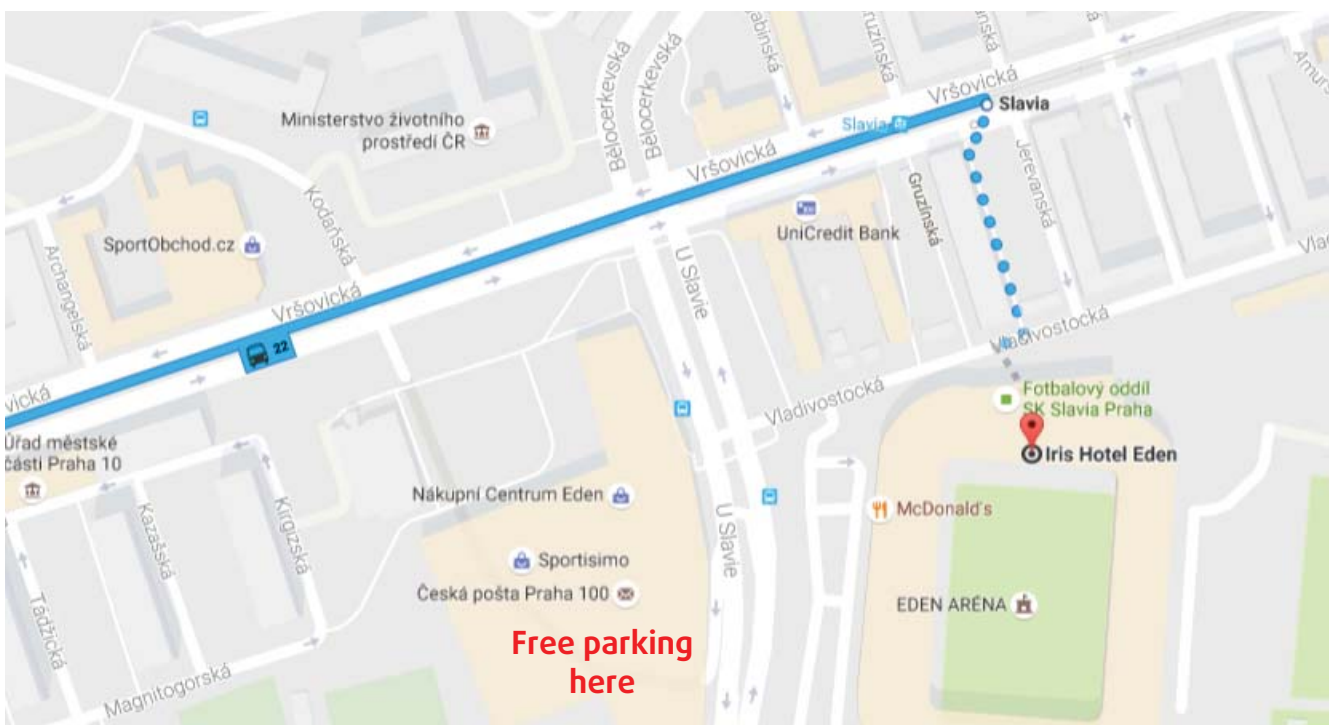
Route from Václav Havel Airport
