- Vault redesign

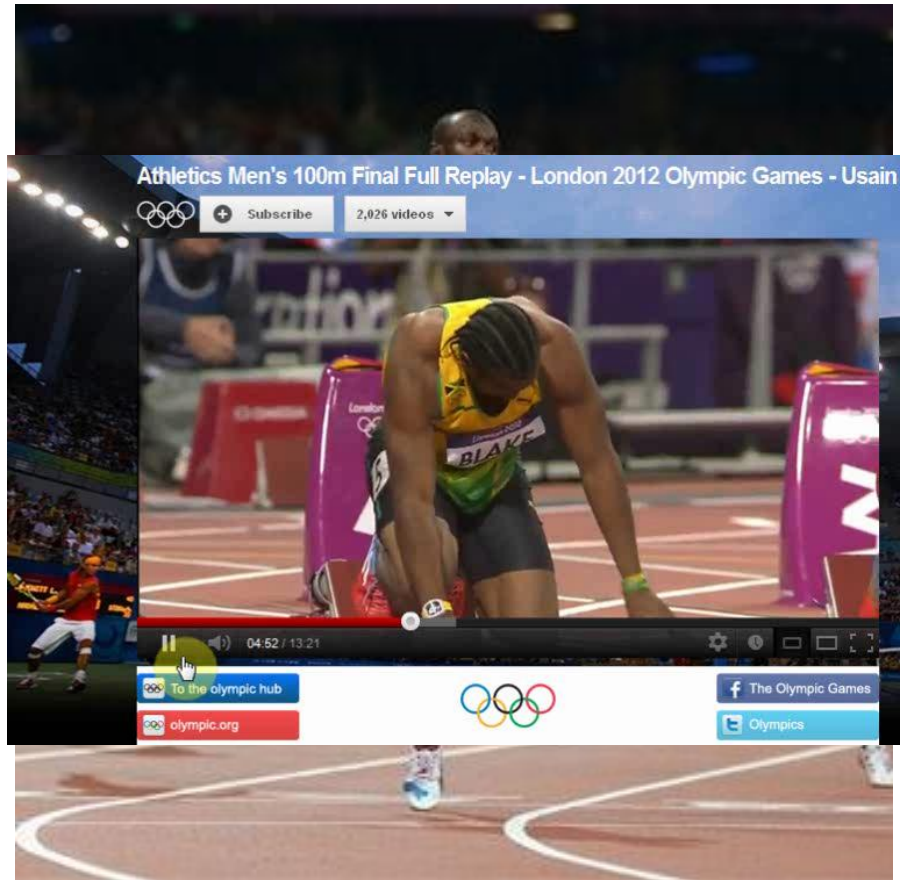
When everything works

- This is a 'team' effort



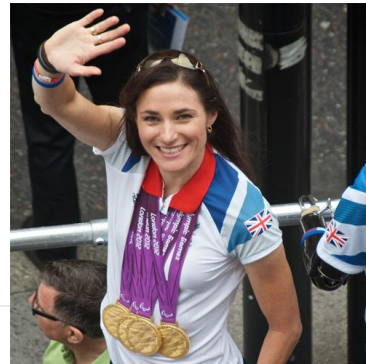
Lean Leadership lessons from Olympians

- Leaders are only as good as their teams

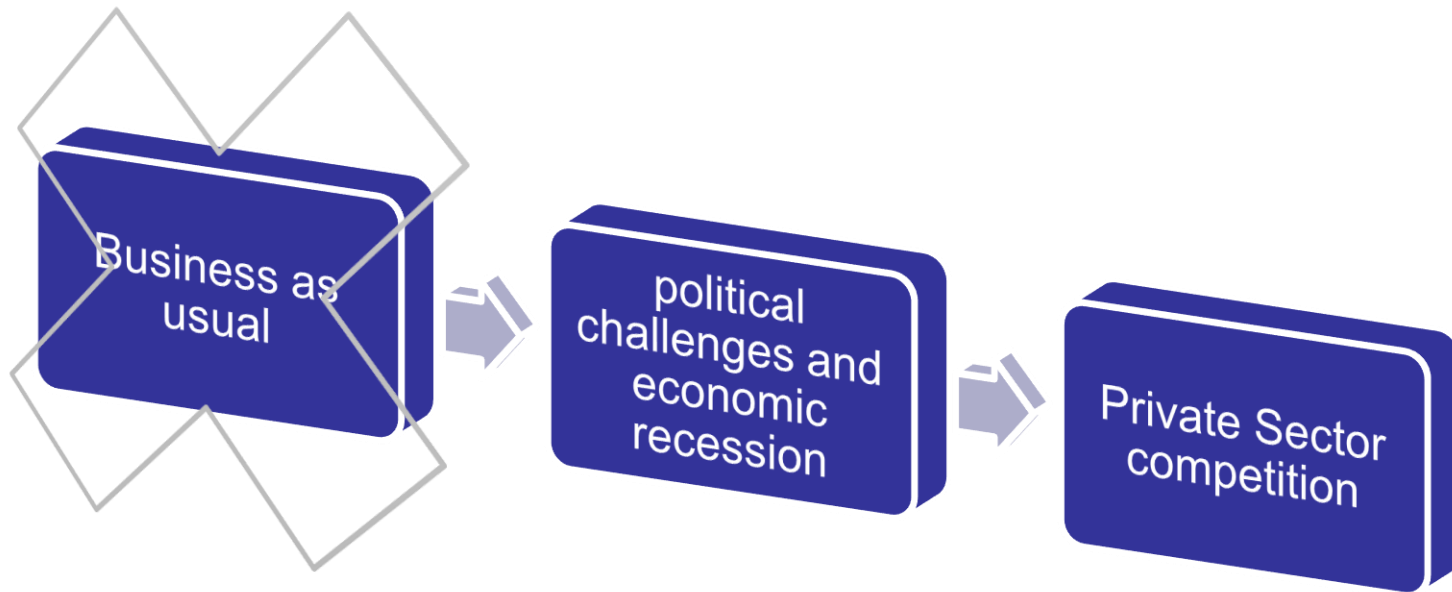


Olympic Flame

- Designed by MMU graduate



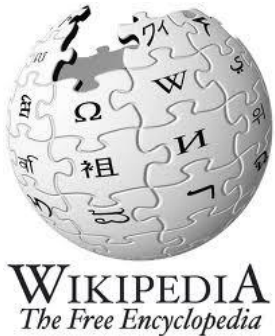
UK Universities 'Olympic' Challenge

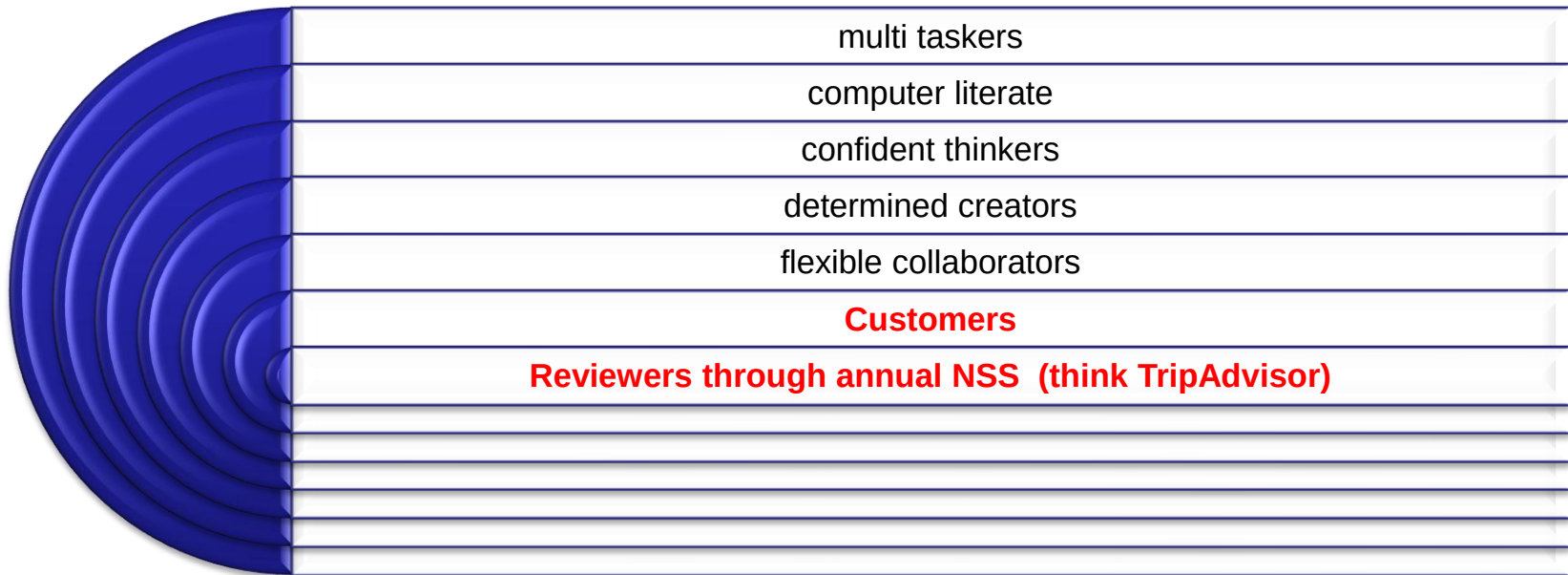
