# THE HISTORICAL ARCHIVES SERVICE

The Historical Archives service of the European Commission is a central service involved in the whole administrative life-cycle of records and files produced by Cabinets / General Directorates / Services/Delegations/Agencies. More specifically:

- ➡ Public access, according to existing regulations,
- to records and files of the European Commission which are of historical, legal or informative value (Historical Archives).
   → Transfer to the central archives repository and management of records and files which are no longer of current
- of records and files which are no longer of current administrative use (intermediate archives), together with search and lending facilities.
- → Contribution to the update and application of procedures and rules for the modern management of records and files.

#### ACCESS

The opening of the historical archives files follows the 30-years rule, in accordance with the Regulation (EC, EURATOM) n° 1700/2003, amending the existing Regulation n° 354/1983.

Exceptions are in line with the principles and limits laid down in the Regulation (EC) n°1049/2001 concerning the public access to documents of European Parliament, Council and Commission, and the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data as established in the Regulation (EC) n° 45/2001.
