1) THE CZECH PRESIDENCY ON BEHALF OF THE MEYS: 30 EVENTS, 10 DOCUMENTS ACCEPTED



"In the context of the Presidency's priorities concerning the education sector, we have managed to fully cover and discuss all topics from school and higher education to youth and sport, and last but not least research and innovation. Immediately after the outbreak of the war in Ukraine, the Czech Republic also added assistance to Ukraine to its presidency priorities, while simultaneously facilitating the coordination of EU Member States in integrating Ukrainian pupils into education systems across the EU. In this area, we have repeatedly received positive feedback from both the EU Member States and the European Commission for the way we ensure an active exchange of information within the EU-27 on the integration of Ukrainian children into their individual education systems. The Czech Republic has performed its tasks as the presiding country in a truly excellent manner and has fulfilled all its political ambitions,"

said Vladimír Balaš, Minister of Education, Youth and Sports, in his assessment of the Czech Presidency of the Council of the EU.

Prague, 11 January 2023 — The Czech Presidency of the Council of the EU, the second in history, was successfully concluded in December. During the six-month leadership of the Council, the MEYS organised thirty international events, both in Prague and Brno, as well as in Brussels, and prepared and negotiated ten official policy documents. Four of them were adopted in the framework of the EU Council for Education, Youth, Culture and Sport (EYCS), and the other six in the research configuration of the EU Competitiveness Council (COMPET).

"Gender equality for me means equality of opportunity, access, behaviour and respect. In my working life, I actively promote the view that age or gender does not matter – I value ability, knowledge, decency and humanity. In my reality, gender is not a decisive factor, nor is it an aspect that I would even primarily consider."

Prague, 21 December 2022 – Women's representation in politics is lagging behind in most countries, including the Czech Republic. Although the situation is gradually improving, statistics show that women remain under-represented in politics and public life at local, national and European level. A positive trend is the situation in the European Parliament, where the number of female MEPs has been increasing with each election and in the current - ninth - term is the highest ever. And what about women who are not visible in the media, but whose work has enabled the Czech Republic to fulfil the priorities of the current EU Presidency? During the Presidency, we will present one of them each month in the form of a profile, always answering the same survey questions. The last one is Eva Húsková, Head of the Communication Department of the Czech EU Presidency at the Office of the Government of the Czech Republic, who concludes the series of Presidency profiles.

6) YOUTH THEMES: MENTAL HEALTH, DIGITALISATION, INCLUSION



"We should ensure meaningful dialogue and involvement of young people in policy-making. To do this, we need to ensure understanding between generations, which I believe is the cornerstone of any meaningful cooperation. On 28 November, the EU Council issued its Conclusions on Intergenerational Cooperation, and we need this document to set the framework for the debate. The task of the Czech Presidency was to create the document, to support existing instruments, such as the Youth Dialogue, and to create new ones. This conference is also based on this innovative approach – as you know, most of today's programme was created by young people for young people," said Education, Youth and Sports Minister Vladimír Baláš at the beginning of the conference.

Young people have spoken out with today's closing conference at the European Parliament in Brussels, "Claim the Future", prepared by the Czech Presidency, the European Parliament and the European Commission. 9) MINISTER BALAŠ CHAIRED THE EU COMPETITIVENESS COUNCIL



"With this session we conclude a substantial part of the political agenda of the Czech Presidency of the Council of the EU. By adopting a pair of EU Council Conclusions, the Ministers of the Member States set out the objectives for the direction of the European research, infrastructure and innovation ecosystem. The ministerial debate then confirmed the central role of science as a tool for informed, evidence-based policy decisions. In the weeks of December, we will still have to negotiate the implementation of the European Chips Act, but it can already be stated that the Czech Republic has performed its tasks as the presiding country to an excellent degree and has fulfilled all its political ambitions," said Vladimír Baláš, Minister of Education, Youth and Sports, in his assessment of the Czech Presidency of the EU Council.

Brussels, 2 December 2022 – The final meeting of the Research Configuration of the EU Competitiveness Council under the Czech Presidency of the EU Council took place today in Brussels. At the meeting, chaired by Education, Youth and Sports Minister Vladimír Baláš, several documents negotiated during the Czech Presidency by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports were adopted. At the end of the meeting, Minister Baláš handed over the presidential baton to Sweden, which will hold the Presidency of the Council of the EU from 1 January next year.

10) THE MEYS ISSUED THE COMENIUS DECLARATION ON THE RUSSIAN AGGRESSION IN UKRAINE

Prague, 1 December 2022 – Today, the MEYS issued an important document commemorating the legacy of humanist and teacher of nations John Amos Comenius and condemning Russian aggression in Ukraine – the Comenius Declaration. It is a declaration of the Czech Republic recalling the main values and principles for which Comenius stood, namely humanism, respect for human rights and education available to all, and also calling on democratic countries and their citizens to realize their duty to defend the values on which our civilization has stood for centuries. The Declaration is supported by Slovenia, Croatia, Lithuania, Estonia, Finland, the Netherlands, Portugal and Spain. Countries that join will be added. The text is also welcomed by Ukraine. The text of the declaration will be presented to the EU Member States at today's European Education Summit by Education, Youth and Sports Minister Vladimír Baláš.

34) DG YOUTH MEETING TOPIC: YOUNG PEOPLE DURING COVID AND THE WAR



*"In order to be a prosperous part of the world in the future, we need to cooperate at the level of individual Member States and we need to invest in the areas we have discussed today, i.e. in science, research, education and innovation, which is why the topics of large major infrastructures and funding have been chosen in the area of research and development," Minister for Science, Research and Innovation **Helena Langšádlová** said and continued: "In addition to national funds, we also need to make very good use of European funds and, most importantly, use them efficiently so that we are able to build an economy with higher added value through investments in these areas and to address the economic challenges that lie ahead of us, be it climate change, digitalisation, security in cyberspace and other social challenges," added Minister **Langšádlová**.*

"In the preparation of the Presidency, I attach great importance to the cooperation between the government and academia, both in terms of expertise and logistics. Among the topics of the Czech Presidency of the Council of the European Union, we want to communicate the area of cyber security and climate policy, for example, deforestation or carbon dioxide storage. We are also considering the possibility of holding some events outside Prague in order to bring the Czech Presidency closer to the Czech public. It is in such cases that cooperation with universities in individual regions can be offered, „Minister for European Affairs **Mikuláš Bek** said at the press conference.

Prague, 3 February 2022 – Today the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports presented its priorities for the upcoming Czech EU Presidency. The key themes heard in the four panels at the round table at the National Technical Library are higher education, research, regional education and youth. The round table was opened by the Minister of Education, Youth and Sports Petr Gazdík, together with the Minister for European Affairs Mikuláš Bek and the Minister for Science, Research and Innovation Helena Langšádlová.

České předsednictví bylo i v této formaci Rady EU velmi aktivní.

Vzdělávání, mládež a sport

V oblastech vzdělávání, mládeže a sportu schválila Rada EU za českého předsednictví čtyři dokumenty. Česká republika se také zaměřila na podporu Ukrajiny a zprostředkovala koordinaci členských států při integraci ukrajinských žáků do vzdělávacích systémů v celé EU.

Jednání Rady EU ve dnech 28. a 29. listopadu 2022 udělalo pomyslnou tečku za českým předsednictvím ve zmíněných oblastech. Ve všech z nich byla vybraná téma inovativní. Některá z nich byla na evropské úrovni otevřena vůbec poprvé.

V oblasti vzdělávání se předsednictví zaměřilo na zajištění dostupnosti kvalitního vzdělávání pro všechny. Dokumenty pokrývají například oblast well-beingu v digitálním vzdělávání, předčasné odchody ze škol nebo zlepšování základních dovedností. V oblasti mládeže úspěšně rezonovala otázka mezigeneračního dialogu a ve sportu udržitelná a přístupná sportovní infrastruktura. České předsednictví v Radě EU zanechalo ve zmíněných témačech jasný strategický odkaz. Vedle toho se všemi tématy prolínala pomoc Ukrajině, kdy Česká republika dosáhla, díky svojí aktivitě a inovativním přístupům, posílení komunikace mezi Ukrajinou a členskými státy.

Member States are responsible for the policy areas covered by the Education, Youth, Culture and Sport Council (EYCS). The EU's role in the fields of education, youth, culture and sport is therefore to provide a framework for cooperation between Member States and for the exchange of information and experience in areas of common interest. The Czech Presidency was also very active in this formation of the Council of the EU.

Education, youth and sport

During the Czech Presidency, the Council of the EU approved four documents in the areas of education, youth and sport. The Czech Republic has also focused on supporting Ukraine and has facilitated coordination between Member States in integrating Ukrainian pupils into education systems across the EU.

The meetings of the Council of the EU on 28 and 29 November 2022 marked the end of the Czech Presidency in these areas. In all of them, the selected topics were innovative. Some of them were opened at European level for the first time.

In the field of education, the Presidency has focused on ensuring access to quality education for all. The documents cover areas such as well-being in digital learning, early leaving from education and improving basic skills. The issue of intergenerational dialogue resonated successfully in the area of youth and sustainable and accessible sports infrastructure in sport. The Czech Presidency of the Council of the EU has left a clear strategic legacy on these topics. In addition, assistance to Ukraine was intertwined with all the topics, where the Czech Republic, thanks to its activity and innovative approaches, achieved a strengthening of communication between Ukraine and the Member States.

Les pays membres sont responsables des domaines des politiques dont s'occupe le Conseil « Éducation, jeunesse, culture et sport » (EJCS). La tâche de l'UE dans les domaines de l'éducation, de la jeunesse, de la culture et du sport est donc de créer un cadre pour une coopération entre les pays membres et pour un échange d'informations et d'expériences dans les domaines d'intérêt commun. The International Conference on Research Infrastructures (ICRI 2022) will take place in Brno from today to Friday, 21 October. It is the largest and most important conference of the research agenda of the Czech EU Presidency programme. Key topics include the benefits of research infrastructures in the light of the coronavirus pandemic or the energy crisis, international cooperation on research infrastructures and their socio-economic impacts. The conference is attended by nearly 450 participants, including representatives of the European Space Agency, the European Molecular Biology Laboratory and other global research institutions, while others can join remotely.

ICRI is a global forum for strategic discussions on research infrastructure policy and its benefits and implications for other sectoral domains. It is organised every two years by the European Commission and the host country, which this year is the Czech Republic.

Which issues in the area of the RDI should be addressed during our Presidency?

Two main priorities have been identified for science and research during the Presidency. The first is synergies in science and research funding – making sure that EU instruments and programmes support each other. Personally, I have advocated that the discussions on synergies in funding should also focus on private sources. The second priority focuses on large research infrastructures, which are a pillar for excellent research but, due to their technological and economic complexity, are entirely dependent on international cooperation. Personally, I have also advocated that research and development in the energy sector should be among the priorities. That's where we really need to focus our attention right now.

What actions is the Ministry preparing in this context?

Until a few months ago, there was only one department in the Office of the Government, and it mainly supported the Government Council for Research, Development and Innovation. Therefore, the MEYS has been responsible for science and research since the beginning of the Presidency. My colleagues from the MEYS are preparing two conferences on these topics and then a meeting of the relevant EU Council departments, and I think they are preparing them very well. Of course, I will attend all the events.
