Would you like to study or do a short-term leadership program in the United States?
Check out these fully-funded opportunities for Czech students.

Benjamin Franklin Transatlantic Fellowship: Students aged **16-18** can spend four weeks in the U.S. through a summer exchange program. Participants explore transatlantic relations, leadership development, critical thinking, diplomacy, community activism, and media. Applications: **February**



Summer Work Travel/BridgeUSA Programs: University students can gain work experience, practice English, get paid, and see the United States! Applications: **From September till December**

EducationUSA: A U.S.-government funded advising center that provides information and counseling about opportunities to study at accredited postsecondary institutions in the U.S.



SUSI Madeleine K. Albright Young Women Leaders Program: Women ages **18-25** can study public policy at the University of Kansas.

IREX CEE (Community Engagement Exchange): A year-long transformational leadership development experience, including a three-month practicum in the U.S., designed to enable **civil society leaders, ages 21-28**, to harness the power of networks, relationships and more!



YTI: The Young Transatlantic Innovation Leaders Initiative is for **emerging entrepreneurs from Europe ages 25-35**. Participants spend several weeks during the spring in the U.S. to develop skills and network with business counterparts as part of a year-long program. Applications: **December**
