Project Management and Task Force (1)



- Project
  - Feasability study is a project
  - Different from running a research programme
  - Different from operating research infrastructure
  - Project Management methodology (PMI, Prince2,..)
- Questions
  - Who acted as PM ?
  - Who knows about PM methodologies ?
  - Who worked in projects with methodology ?



Project Management and Task Force (2)



- Facts on IT projects (PMI)
  - 31% cancelled before completion
  - 53% of completed projects cost overruns and time delays and/or quality problems
  - 1 of 8, considered truly successful
- "Chaos report" by Standish group 1995-2002
  - Cost average: 189%
  - Time average: 222%
- What are the top reasons for project failure?
  - Poor leadership at all levels (top down)
  - Inadequately training or inexperienced project managers/stakeholders
  - Failure to manage expectations and scope

Project Management and Task Force (4)



- Value from implementing PM
  - Tangible outputs
    - Reduced failure rate
    - Less time delays and cost overruns
  - Intangible outputs
    - Improved effectiveness of the organisation

Project Management and Task Force (5)



- Creation of the task force
  - Project Director + limited number of area leaders
  - As early as possible
  - Roles and responsabilities
  - Commitment of leaders is key for success

Project Management and Task Force (6)



- Purpose of the task force
  - Select PM methodology and organize PM training
  - Lead the development of feasibility study
  - Monitor regularly the progress against the plan: Scope, Risk, Quality, Schedule, Cost,... Procurement, Human Resources...
  - Decision taking linked to milestones
  - Provide needed resources
  - Keeping overview, focus on workpackages and milestones

Project Management and Task Force (7)



- Assisted by, make use of it
  - External consultants
  - Internal staff
  - MEYS, Jaspers
- As for each project
  - Open brain storming session
  - Early deliveries, prototyping and testing
  - Balance between good management and the innovation capacity of research institutes
- Result is evaluated by
  - Researchers, taskforce, MEYS, Jaspers, DG-Regio



- Ideas how to facilitate the project
  - PM training for project managers+taskforce+MEYS
  - Certification + career path for project managers

- However
  - It remains your project under your responsibility
  - No insurance against failure, even with PM methodology
